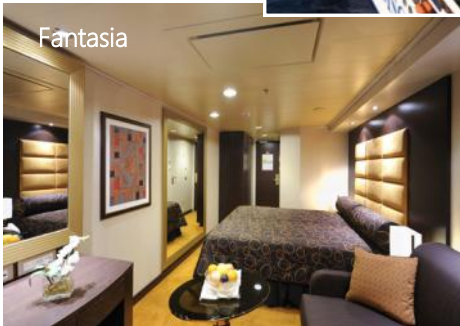

All Mediterranean Cruise – Ports of Call

BARCELONA, SPAIN

Barcelona is an intriguing mix of very old and very modern. From the ancient ruins of a Roman Temple in the Gothic Quarter to the structures built for the 1992 Summer Olympics. Barcelona is a city of contrast with its whimsical architecture of Antoni Gaudi, world class museums, fashionable shopping and fine cuisine.

CIVITAVECCHIA (ROME), ITALY

From the port of Civitavecchia it is not far to the imposing ancient city of Rome, incomparable in terms of monuments, gardens, villas, and works of art: to name but a few, the Coliseum, the Capitol, Saint Peter's Basilica, ancient Ostia with the famous mosaics in the Baths of Neptune.

CORFU, GREECE

Homer's island has enchanted visitors for ages, with its picturesque landscape and delightful climate. For many years the island fell under Venetian rule and later became a British protectorate. These influences can be seen in the Renaissance and Georgian-style architecture of the main town, with its arcaded shopping plaza and a cricket pitch in the main square.

GENOA, ITALY

Genoa is a leading Italian port, university town and a major commercial center. Its history dates back to 218 BC. when the city was founded by the Ligurians. Today, the old town boasts narrow, busy streets with a typical Mediterranean ambiance, while the new town features modern buildings, gardens and villas.

HERAKLION, (CRETE) GREECE

Heraklion is the capital and principal port of Crete. Just three miles away from the fantastic ruins of the Palace of Knossos. Discovered in 1899 by Sir Arthur Evans and partially reconstructed, the elaborate Palace is believed to be the mythical Labyrinth of King Minos and the seat of ancient Minoan culture.

KATAKOLON (OLYMPIA), GREECE

Katakolon, a charming fishing village, is port to Olympia, a sacred precinct built for the quadrennial games dedicated to Zeus. From Katakolon you are within touching distance of where the Olympic Games started and the Olympic flame is still lit here every four years.

MARSEILLE, FRANCE

For 2600 years, Marseille has been a port from Massalia, the Phoenician city, to Marseille "gateway to the East", maritime adventure and the rapid expansion of trade in the 19th century are evoked from the Old Port.

PIRAEUS (ATHENS), GREECE

Piraeus has been the port of Athens for over 2500 years. Though a busy place, it has a charm of its own. Athens, the capital of Greece, is the cradle of democracy and the birthplace of Western Civilization. Athens is a vibrant city where old and new co-exist.

VALLETTA, MALTA

Rich in history and culture, Malta is a marvel made up of stunning buildings: a visit to the capital reveals the main historic buildings, while the tour of the megalithic temples of Hagar Quim and Tarsia and the cave of Ghar Dalam shows the remote past of this island.
