**AMSTERDAM, NETHERLANDS**

Amsterdam has many world famous tourist sites such as: the Anne Frank Huis, where Anne and her family lived in hiding during the II World War, the **Van Gogh Museum**, and the Rijksmuseum, with its extraordinary collection of paintings by Rembrandt. Relax with a stroll in the nearby **Vondelpark**, the most beautiful of Amsterdam's parks. The greatest attraction however are the canals, as you won't fail to notice. You will find an incredible number of bars, clubs and coffee shops where you can have a drink, from the traditional bruin café to the many trendy haunts.

**BILBOA, SPAIN**

The biggest city in the Basque Country has plenty to offer, from its exuberant cutting-edge architecture and stimulating museums to its friendly inhabitants. Despite its name, the **Casco Viejo** ("old town"), is not in fact the oldest part of Bilbao. The city started out as a cluster of small fishing villages on the left bank of the river, whereas the Casco Viejo grew up across the river between the fourteenth and nineteenth centuries. All the oldest buildings that still survive, are now concentrated here. This tight-knit labyrinth of old stone lanes, filled with bars and restaurants and cradling the delightful arcaded main square, the Plaza Nueva, also holds some interesting museums.

**HAMBURG, GERMANY**

Kiel is approximately 90 kilometres (56 mi) to the north of Hamburg on the shore of the Baltic Sea. Hamburg is a place where anything can – and frequently does – happen, like giving the world its first glimpse of The Beatles. World War II inflicted severe damage, but the city's medieval character is still evident thanks to post-war restorations.

**LA CORUNA, SPAIN**

Galician soul. The fine port of La Coruña centres on a narrow peninsula that juts from Spain's northern coast, 64km north of Santiago. In the dynamic city in between, a five-minute walk by way of old stone alleyways, with tantalizing restaurants, tapas bars and nightspots jostling for attention, takes you from bustling modern port. The heart of La Coruña, poised between the old city and its modern sprawl just inland from the port, is the colonnaded Praza de María Pita. The narrow and atmospheric streets of the old town wind around the Romanesque churches of Santiago and Santa María del Campo, and are shielded from the sea by a high wall.

**LE HAVRE, FRANCE**

A dazzling example of contemporary architecture and an important port in Northern France. Following its near-destruction during World War II, Le Havre was rebuilt by a single architect,

Auguste Perret, between 1946 and 1964. A full day tour to Paris is offered from this port-of-call as well.

**LEVERDON-SUR-MER, FRANCE**

Enjoy a pleasant stroll around the town itself in this charming Bordeaux region. First walk around the pleasure port, then take a look at the 19th century Church of Notre-Dame du Bon Secours et de Saint-Louis. This church was built on the site of an earlier chapel after the council decided that a church with a tall spire was required as a warning to ships offshore. You can also see the town hall, set in a large area of gardens. There are various restaurants both in the town, at the Pointe de Grave, and near the beaches.

**SOUTHAMPTON, ENGLAND**

Despite its pummeling by the Luftwaffe and some disastrous postwar urban sprawl, the thousand-year-old city of Southampton has retained some of its medieval charm in parts and reinvented itself as a twenty-first century shopping centre in others, with the giant glass-and-steel West Quay as its focus. Core of the modern town is the Civic Centre, a short walk east of the train station and home to the excellent Southampton City Art Gallery that's particularly strong on contemporary British artists. The Western Esplanade runs alongside the best remaining bits of the old city walls.
