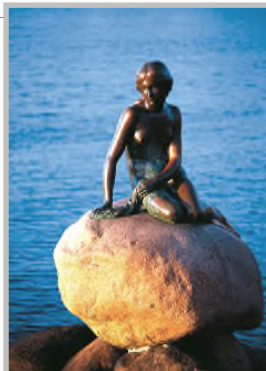

AKUREYRI, ICELAND

Akureyri is situated at the head of the country's longest fjord and a snowball's throw from the 'Waterfall of the Gods' at Godafoss and the *Botanical Gardens*.

HELLESYLT/GEIRANGER

Hellesylt is a beautiful tiny ferry port on the magnificent Geiranger fjord and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site in western Norway. The Hellesylt waterfall and the cliffs that plunge into Horindalsvannet, Europe's deepest lake (nearly 2,000 feet) are just some of the stunning sights that lie in store.

HAUGESUND, NORWAY

Haugesund is a vibrant and historic town dating back to Viking times. This is where, a thousand years ago, King Harald Fairhair united Norway into a single kingdom, and it was from this area that the Viking Kings ruled Norway for more than 500 years.

EDINBURGH, SCOTLAND

The Orkneys comprise 70 or so islands, rocks and skerries of the north Scottish coast. The Stone Age settlement of

Skara Brae is older than the Pyramids or Stonehenge.

INVERGORDON, SCOTLAND

Invergordon lies in a particularly beautiful part of the Highlands of Scotland. The village lies near the head of a Firth or Fjord on an arm of the North Sea, and is surrounded by mountains and gentle rolling farmland. Attractions include Cawdor Castle, Dunrobin Castle, Brodie Castle, Loch Ness and its famous monster "Nessie", Dornoch Cathedral and more.
